The Squaw Creek Irrigation Ditch, surveyed
May 29, 1897. Syd. Windan and David Fryrear, chain-
men, Erax Johnston, surveyor.

Commencing at a point N. 30° 30' West from the
SE cor. of Sec. 29, T. 15 S. R. 10 E. 23.25 chains distant
where we placed a stone 12 x 12 x 15 in, marked S. From
which a pine tree 8 inches dia bears E. 18° S. 59 links
distant, marked S.

The stakes marked S are at the points of angles, with the trees are not, but are within 25 links of the points of angles.

Notice is hereby given that we, the undersigned, M. D. Powell and R. E. Fortman, as equal partners therein, do hereby claim for the purpose of irrigation, the following described ditch, to-wit:

Commencing at the south east corner of the north east quarter of the north west quarter of section 18, in township 14 south, of range 16 east, of Willamette Meridian, and running thence east 29 rods; thence in a southern course 80 rods to T. J. Powell's land, crossing the county road about 8 rods east of the SW corner of William Pitcher's land; thence in a southeasterly course to the NW corner of the land of M. D. Powell; said ditch to be six feet wide at the mouth and two feet deep.
